A good boat for family cruising holidays or liveaboard.

Start at the bow you enter the saloon equipped with an L-shaped dinette, which make a single bed, and storage below, built in TV cabinet and JVC Tv. The Aarrow solid fuel Stove is fitted between the saloon and galley, offering heating throughout the living quarters.

The Galley has laminate worktops, equipped with the Oven Grill and Hob built in Lec Fridge and lots of cupboard and drawers for storage. An inset stainless-steel sink and drainer along with a mono-block mixer tap, and wall mounted Morco water heater above.

After the galley is the self contained pullman dinette which comprises of 2 bench seats & storage below also converts to a double bed. Built in cupboards run along the starboard side of the dinette area useful for setting up the dinette.

Next you have the enclosed shower and toilet area, with a counter-top elliptical vanity basin with cupboard below. Full size shower and drop through toilet.

Following on, you're in the main bedroom with a fixed double, wardrobe space, a Houdini hatch is located above the bed.

Finally, you have the cockpit with solar controller, vetus battery monitor, Procharge 12v-30amp charger, and the usual morse control lever.
